

Statement of Compliance for Users of AWID Proximity Readers in the European Union

R&TTE Directive 1999/5/EC, Article 6.3, requires that the following statement be included in shipments of the equipment to which Article 6.3 applies.

This AWID Proximity Reader is classified as a Short-Range Device containing a radio transmitter. All models of AWID's Proximity Readers use 125 kHz wireless communications between the readers and their associated encoded credentials (cards, keytags, and wafers in various configurations).

In Annex 9 of the Directive – Inductive Devices of ERC Recommendation 70-03, May 2001 – Short-Range Devices using 125 kHz communications are classified for Free Circulation and as Unlicensed products for the 15 countries in the European Community.
